Bullying is a significant workplace health and safety hazard.

The objectives of this event are to raise public awareness around the serious issue of workplace bullying and to increase knowledge around what individuals can do and what their rights are should they feel bullied.

This event provides a platform for robust conversation around bullying, discussing what bullying is and the impact it can have. We will also look at the solutions for keeping yourself and your colleagues safe.

A specialist panel will comprise:

Robyn Hutchison, who recently won an Employment Court case against her former Nelson City Council employer for wrongful dismissal, because she had been fired for speaking out about a colleague who took his own life as a result of workplace bullying that she had witnessed.

Allan Halse, who has also been publically dismissed by Hamilton City Council for blowing the whistle on workplace bullying that he had witnessed in his role as a union delegate and who is now leading this initiative as Director of CultureSafe NZ.

Chontelle Climo, Solicitor Whitfield Braun who has expertise in this area of the health and safety aspects of employment relations.
